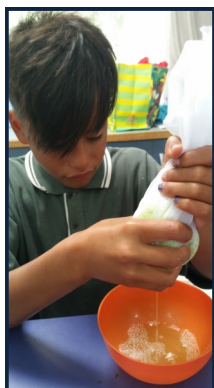
Our 50 DOJO points reward time has finally happened today. Students have swum, biked, played and enjoyed lucky dips.
