PRESCHOOLERS

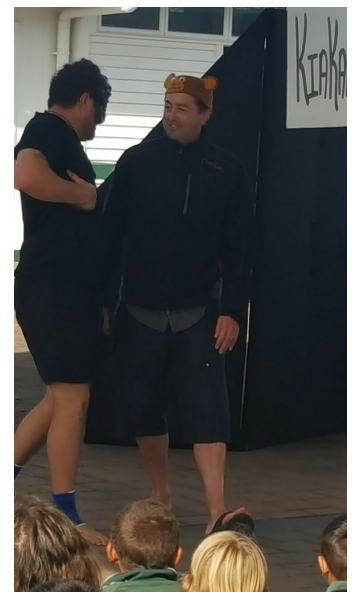
Have you got any preschoolers in your family?
