GROWING GREAT LEARNERS

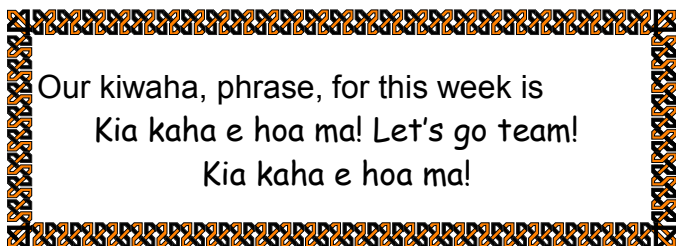

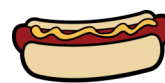
