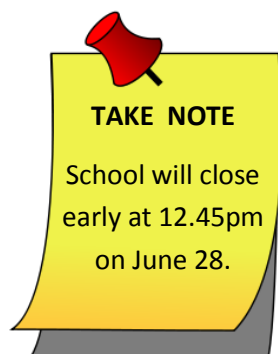


On Thursday and Friday we invite you to come in to school and view our Art Exhibition, the
