The teachers are very excited about the opportunities they have planned for the students.

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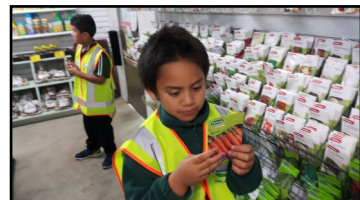
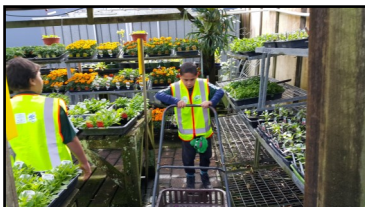
Camp fees are due now.
