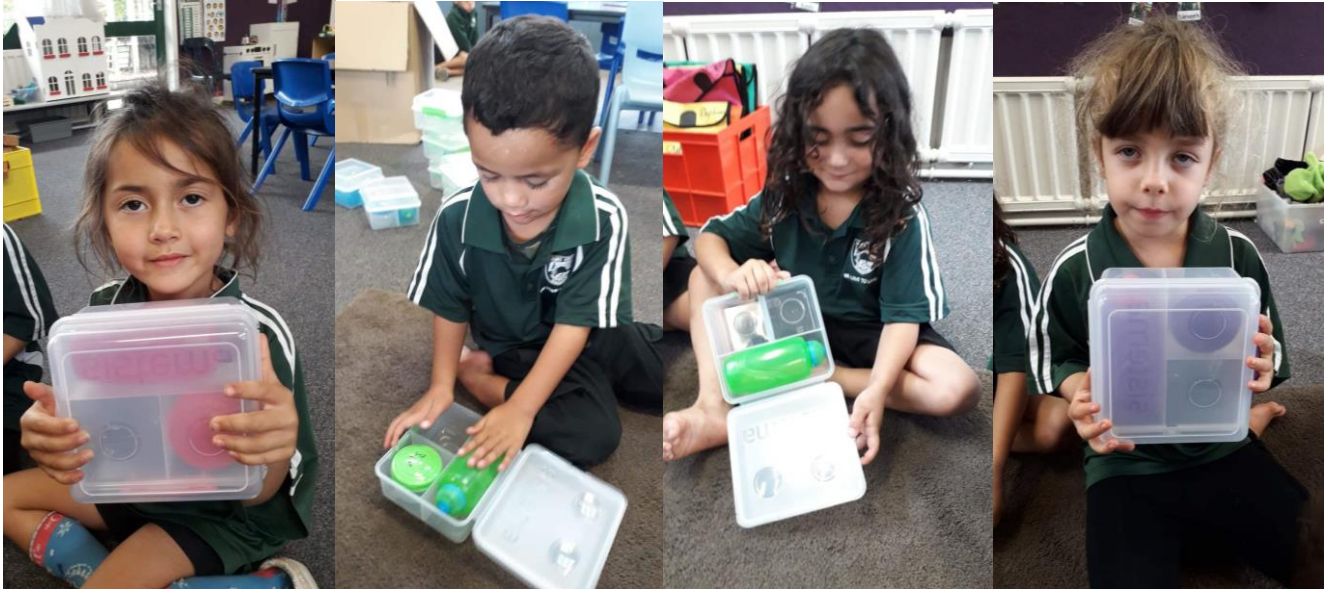
Week Ten Term One 2019 -2 April

Growing Great Learners

This week we are learning to follow the bike safety rules.

2. We write our name on the whiteboard outside the bike shed
3. We choose a bike that is the right size for us and clip a helmet on our heads
4. We make sure the helmet fits and is clipped up snugly around our chins

6. When the bell rings we return our bike and helmet back to the bike shed, walking it behind Totara.
