Week Nine Term Two 2019 - 25 June

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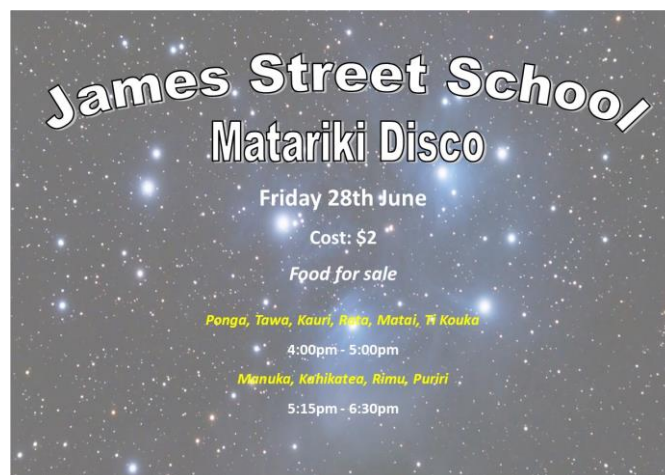
